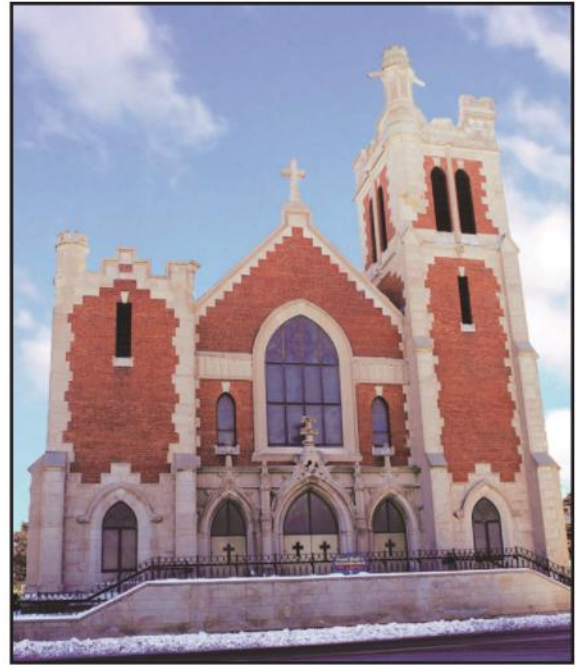

### FYI-WOULD DONATING YOUR RMD BENEFIT YOU TOO?

Currently, at age 73, the federal government requires distributions from most retirement accounts including Individual Retirement Accounts (IRAs). This distribution, or Required Minimum Distribution (RMD), is mandated so the federal government can tax the distribution. For some, this distribution is unwanted as it could create an unwanted tax burden and may even result in an increased tax bracket.

A recent change to the tax code allows someone subject to RMDs to donate the RMD to charity. An RMD donated to charity does not result in an increase in taxes to the tax payer. Additionally, the portion of the RMD given to the charity is not subject to any taxation, thus the charity receives the full RMD. Your parish is an approved charity.

If you are currently subject to an RMD, you may have all, or a portion of the RMD donated to your parish. You will owe no taxes on an RMD donated to your parish.

Again, you can donate the entire RMD, or a designated portion of your RMD. Tax avoidance may not be your only motivation for considering the donation of your RMD; your parish needs to increase revenue to sustain our existence and our commitments to our community. A conversation with your tax professional is recommended to insure the donation of your RMD is appropriate.

Some of your fellow parishioners have already begun gifting their RMDs to our parish. If you need more information on the process, please contact the parish office.

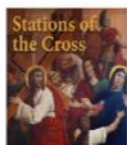

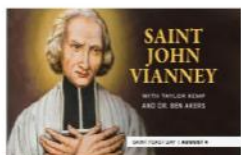
**Ignatius of Loyola**
