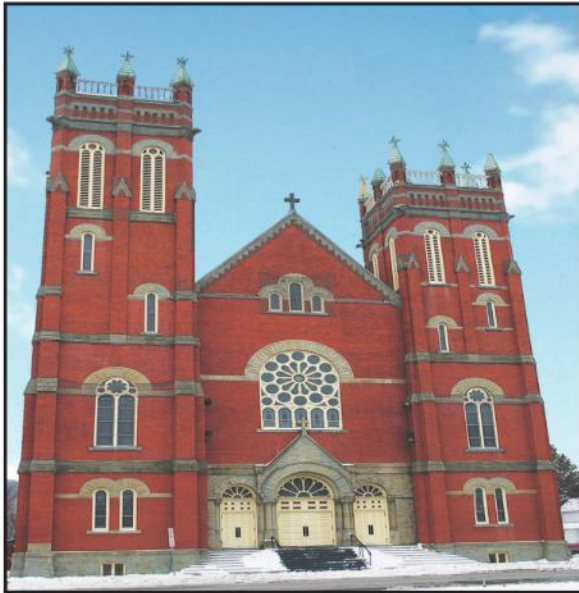

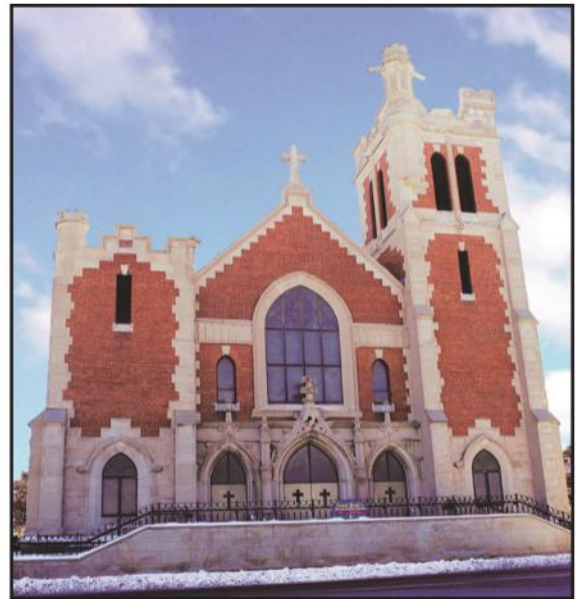

SPONSORSHIP FOR BAPTISMS OR CONFIRMATION— Anyone looking to be a Godparent or Sponsor to a Confirmation candidate MUST be registered as a member of either St. Mary's or St. Paul's to be able to get a letter of certification. This is the only way that the Church can verify you are a practicing Catholic. Cannon law requires you are to be a practicing Catholic to be a sponsor.
