All are welcome! This is a wonderful family event; any and all single or combined family units are welcome. Line the basket and cover the food with a covering to symbolize Christ's burial shroud. Colorful ribbons, greenery, dried flowers, are a few of the suggestions to symbolize spring, renewal and the Resurrection. The roots of this tradition date back to the early 12th century history of Poland, and is now observed by expatriates and their descendent Poles in the U.S., Canada and the United Kingdom, and other Polish parish communities.


